

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

To enable the statutory duties imposed by the Health and Safety at Work act 1974 to be carried out, by both Employer and Employees, it is our intent to ensure that responsibilities are communicated to all levels and that adequate provision is available to implement them.

Our general policy is:

- 1. To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities
- 2. To consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety
- 3. To provide and maintain safe equipment and provide first aid stations on each vehicle
- 4. Ensure that all employees are competent to carry out their tasks and to give them adequate training
- 5. To ensure the use, handling, storage and transportation of tools and substances for work purposes are safe and without risks to health
- 6. To prevent accidents and cases of work related ill health
- 7. To maintain safe and healthy working conditions and provide accident record books at the head office
- 8. Ensure that risk assessments are carried out and reviewed and that method statements are available for each activity
